

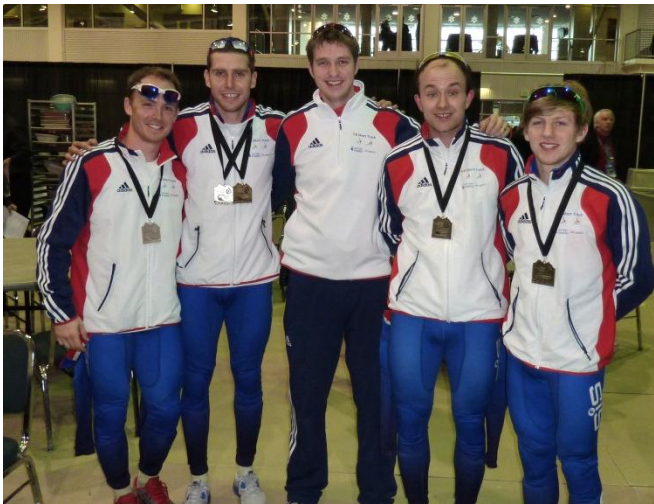
Season 2011/12 World Cups I & II
